WHEREAS, In 2016, Appellant University of San Francisco ("Appellant" or "USF") submitted a permit application for the Student Residence Hall Project, consisting of two buildings with combined 155 units for student residents hall an office space, at the USF - Lone Mountain Campus; and

WHEREAS, On October 31, 2018, the Appellant filed a timely appeal to the Board of Supervisors for a reduction, adjustment or waiver of the fee requirements based upon the absence of any reasonable relationship or nexus between the impact of development and the amount of the fee charged; and

WHEREAS, On December 11, 2018, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider the appeal filed by the Appellant; and

WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered all documents submitted by the Appellant and all other written records before the Board of Supervisors, and heard testimony and received public comment regarding the appeal, and said documents and testimony are incorporated herein by reference; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board concludes that the Appellant has not met the burden of presenting substantial evidence to support the appeal, including comparable technical

information to support the Appellant's position that there is no reasonable relationship or nexus between the impact of development and the amount of the fee charged; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board denies the Appellant's request to waive, adjust or reduce the fee, and hereby approves the imposition of the fee pursuant to the Planning Code.
