Resolution commending and honoring Supervisor Jane Kim for her distinguished service as a Member of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors.

WHEREAS, Supervisor Jane Kim has served the people of the City and County of San Francisco with dedication for eight years as a member of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Kim served the children and parents of San Francisco Unified School District as a School Board commissioner while attending University of Berkeley's School of Law at the same time before being drafted to run for Supervisor of District 6; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Kim has the distinction of having represented the most diverse and vibrant district in San Francisco, which includes three Cultural Heritage Districts, three Police Districts, five Community Benefit Districts, one ballpark, two islands and both the wealthiest and the poorest residents in the entire city; and
