Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Increasing Compensation - Assessment Appeals Board Members]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to increase compensation received by members of the Assessment Appeals Board to \$125 for each hearing, or for each morning or afternoon of a hearing, not to exceed \$375 per day; except, when sitting individually as an assessment hearing officer, members receive \$125 for each morning or afternoon of service, not to exceed \$250 per day.

Existing Law

Members of the Assessment Appeals Boards receive \$100 for each half-day of service on any Board. Members serving as assessment hearing officers receive the same compensation.

Amendments to Current Law

For members serving on a Board panel, compensation would increase to \$125 for each hearing on which the member serves, if confined to a morning or afternoon; and if continued, \$125 for each morning or each afternoon of the continued hearing. "Hearing" means the Board or a panel of the Board convening to consider the matter or matters that appear on a single meeting agenda.

For members serving as assessment hearing officers, compensation would increase to \$125 for each morning or afternoon of service.

For members serving in either capacity, compensation would be limited to a maximum of \$375 for each calendar day.
