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[Settlement of Lawsuit - Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company - \$760,000]

Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by City and County of San Francisco against the Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company for \$760,000; the lawsuit was filed on October 2, 2015, in United States District Court, Case No. 15-cv-04557; entitled City and County of San Francisco v. Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company; the lawsuit involves a dispute over whether the City is covered under the terms of a commercial liability insurance policy.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled City and County of San Francisco v. Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company, United States District Court, Case No. 15-cv-04557 by the payment of \$760,000. The lawsuit involves a dispute over whether the City is covered as an additional insured under a commercial liability insurance policy issued by Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in United States District Court on October 2, 2015, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: plaintiff: City and County of San Francisco; defendant: Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company.


