Ordinance authorizing the installation of up to 34 banners on City-owned utility poles by APA Family Support Services under Public Works Code, Section 184.78, at 1654 Sunnydale Avenue, Hunters View Apartments, at and around 159 West Point Road, Alice Griffith Apartments, at and around 2700 Arelious Walker Drive, Sunnydale-Velasco Apartments, between 1657 and 1583 Sunnydale Avenue, Potrero Terrace and Annex, at and around 1095 Connecticut Street, and along Bayshore Boulevard and Third Street, between January 17, 2019, and July 17, 2019; and waiving the fees for those banners.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Background and Findings.

(a) APA Family Support Services ("APA") is a 501(c)(3) non-profit agency that is committed to family and child wellness and prevention of domestic violence and child abuse. APA is currently facilitating the District 10 Oral Health Task Force, which aims to reduce tooth decay and cavities among infants and children in the neighborhoods of Visitacion Valley and Bayview Hunters Point, partly by providing education to pregnant women regarding oral health for infants and children. As one step in this effort, APA intends to place banners on light poles on City streets to educate the public about the importance of children's oral health behaviors.

(b) APA intends to install up to 34 banners, subject to approval by the Department of Public Works ("Public Works"). APA seeks to install the banners along the street at and around 1654 Sunnydale Avenue, Hunters View Apartments at and around 159 West Point Road, Alice Griffith Apartments at and around 2700 Arelious Walker Drive, Sunnydale-Velasco Apartments between 1657 and 1583 Sunnydale Avenue, Potrero Terrace and Annex at and around 1095 Connecticut Street, and along Bayshore Boulevard and Third Street.

Section 2. Authorization to Install Banners; Fee Waiver.

- (a) Notwithstanding Public Works Code Section 184.78(c)'s limitation on the types of banners that may be posted on City-owned utility poles, and Section 184.78(h)'s prohibition on posting of banners in Residential zoning districts, Public Works shall authorize APA to post up to 34 banners on City-owned utility poles at the addresses listed in Section 1 of this ordinance between January 17, 2019 and July 17, 2019, to promote infant and child oral health.
- (b) The fees set forth in Public Works Code Section 184.78 shall be waived for APA for up to 34 banners posted on City-owned utility poles at the locations and during the time period specified in subsection (a).
- (c) All other provisions of Public Works Code Section 184.78 shall apply to APA's application and banners.

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Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

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## LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Authorization for Banners on City-Owned Utility Poles - Waiver of Banner Fee - APA Family Support Services]

Ordinance authorizing the installation of up to 34 banners on City-owned utility poles by APA Family Support Services under Public Works Code, Section 184.78, at 1654 Sunnydale Avenue, Hunters View Apartments, at and around 159 West Point Road, Alice Griffith Apartments, at and around 2700 Arelious Walker Drive, Sunnydale-Velasco Apartments, between 1657 and 1583 Sunnydale Avenue, Potrero Terrace and Annex, at and around 1095 Connecticut Street, and along Bayshore Boulevard and Third Street, between January 17, 2019, and July 17, 2019; and waiving the fees for those banners.

## **Existing Law**

Under existing law, the Department of Public Works may authorize the placement of banners on City-owned utility poles in specified circumstances. The organization placing banners on the poles must pay a fee to the City.

## Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would authorize APA Family Support Services to install up to 34 banners on City-owned utility poles between January 17, 2019, and July 17, 2019. The banners would provide information to educate the public about the importance of children's oral health. The banners would be located at 1654 Sunnydale Avenue, Hunters View Apartments at and around 159 West Point Road, Alice Griffith Apartments at and around 2700 Arelious Walker Drive, Sunnydale-Velasco Apartments between 1657 and 1583 Sunnydale Avenue, Potrero Terrace and Annex at and around 1095 Connecticut Street, and along Bayshore Boulevard and Third Street. The ordinance would also waive the fee for installation of the banners.


