[Appointment, San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission - Supervisor Gordon Mar]

Motion appointing Supervisor Gordon Mar, terms ending February 4, 2022, to the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission.

California Government Code, Section 56325, provides that the Local Agency Formation Commission shall consist of either four members of the Board of Supervisors, or three members of the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor. All four members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. These four members shall select a public member to serve as the fifth member. The Board must also select two alternate commissioners.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as a member and alternate member of the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission, pursuant to the provisions of California Government Code, Section 56325, for the terms specified:

Supervisor Gordon Mar, seat 4, succeeding Eric Mar, term expired, must be a member of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors and appointed by the Board of Supervisors, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending February 4, 2022.

Poll Results for Outside Boards and Commissions

On January 16, 2019, a memo was sent to all Members of the Board of Supervisors, surveying their interest in serving on recently available Seats to outside boards and commissions.

Analysis:

The below nominations are based upon current Seats held and seniority, pursuant to Board Rules 6.2 and 6.5:

- Association of Bay Area Government (ABAG) Supervisor Haney expressed interest in being appointed to Seat 5, the remaining Seats 3, 4 and 6 will remain vacant. Therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Haney to the Rules Committee.
- Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC) Supervisor Stefani expressed interest in Seat 2 (alternate appointment). Therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Stefani to the Rules Committee.
- Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District Board of Directors (GGBHTD) Supervisor Walton expressed interest in appointment to Seat 7. Therefore, we will forward the
 nomination of Supervisor Walton to the Rules Committee.
- California State Association of Counties (CSAC) All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to Seats 1 and 2, therefore, CSAC will not have Board representation.
- City College Financial Assistance Fund Oversight Committee Supervisor Mar expressed interest in appointment to Seat 1. Therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Mar to the Rules Committee.
- Economic Opportunity Council All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to Seat 1, therefore, the council will not have Board representation.
- Transbay Joint Powers Authority Board of Directors Supervisors Haney and Walton expressed interest in appointment to Seat 2. Therefore, pursuant to Board Rule 6.2 which states that appointments to compensated positions will be determined by seniority, we will be forwarding the nomination of Supervisor Haney to the Rules Committee.

- Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) Supervisors Mar and Haney expressed interest in Seats 2 and 4. Therefore, we will forward the nominations of Supervisors Mar and Haney to the Rules Committee.
- Urban Counties Caucus All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to Seat 1, therefore, the caucus will not have Board representation.
- San Francisco Airport (SFO) Community Roundtable All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to the alternate Seat 2.

For all the remaining vacancies, we will poll again in the Spring.

Three Supervisors serve on the Executive Committee of the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG). One appointment rotates each two years between the Board and the Mayor. In 2011 the seat is an appointment of the Board. There are three alternate members. The Committee meets about six times a year, usually on the third Thursday of each month at 7:30 p.m. at 101 8th Street in Oakland, next to the Lake Merritt BART Station. Members are each paid \$150 a meeting. Please contact Fred Castro at (415) 464-7913 or you may visit their website: www.abag.ca.gov for scheduled meetings.

One Supervisor sits and serves on the California Associations of Counties. CSAC Board Members meet four times in one year: The Member is entitled to receive compensation for CSAC meeting related expenses, limited to \$1,000 per year. One Supervisor sits on the City College Financial Assistance Fund Oversight Committee. They shall review City College's implementation of the grant agreement and to prepare an annual public report to the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors, and the Department of Children, Youth, and Their Families, as well as to City College, concerning the implementation of the grant agreement and disbursements from the fund. Board Qualifications:

The Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) shall consist of a total of seven (7) members, five (5) of whom are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The composition of the members are as follows:

- > Four (4) members from the Board of Supervisors and appointed by the Board: two (2) as county representatives, and two (2) as city representatives;
- > One (1) public member-at-large appointed by the four commissioners from the Board of Supervisors:
- > One (1) alternate member from the Board of Supervisors and appointed by the Board; and
- > One (1) alternate public member-at-large selected by the four commissioners from the Board of Supervisors.

The term of each member shall be four years. Commissioners serve until the appointment of a successor or until removed by the appointing body. To promote continuity, the initial successors to one of the County members and one of the City members appointed in 2001 will not be appointed until two years after the initial terms have expired.

LAFCo is responsible for reviewing and approving proposed jurisdictional boundary changes, including annexations and detachments of territory to and/or from cities and special districts, incorporations of new cities, formations of new special districts, and consolidations, mergers and dissolution of existing districts. In addition, LAFCo must review and approve contractual service agreements, determine spheres of influence for each city and district, and may initiate

proposals involving district consolidation, dissolution, establishment of subsidiary districts, mergers, and reorganizations (combinations of these jurisdictional changes).
