On January 16, 2019, a memo was sent to all Members of the Board of Supervisors, surveying their interest in serving on recently available Seats to outside boards and commissions.

Analysis:

BOARD of SUPERVISORS

The below nominations are based upon current Seats held and seniority, pursuant to Board Rules 6.2 and 6.5:

- Association of Bay Area Government (ABAG) Supervisor Haney expressed interest in being appointed to Seat 5, the remaining Seats 3, 4 and 6 will remain vacant. Therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Haney to the Rules Committee.
- Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC) Supervisor Stefani expressed interest in Seat 2 (alternate appointment). Therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Stefani to the Rules Committee.
- Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District Board of Directors (GGBHTD) --Supervisor Walton expressed interest in appointment to Seat 7. Therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Walton to the Rules Committee.
- California State Association of Counties (CSAC) All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to Seats 1 and 2, therefore, CSAC will not have Board representation.
- City College Financial Assistance Fund Oversight Committee Supervisor Mar expressed interest in appointment to Seat 1. Therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Mar to the Rules Committee.
- Economic Opportunity Council All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to Seat 1, therefore, the council will not have Board representation.
- Transbay Joint Powers Authority Board of Directors Supervisors Haney and Walton expressed interest in appointment to Seat 2. Therefore, pursuant to Board Rule 6.2 which states that appointments to compensated positions will be determined by seniority, we will be forwarding the nomination of Supervisor Haney to the Rules Committee.

Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) - Supervisors Mar and Haney expressed interest in Seats 2 and 4. Therefore, we will forward the nominations of Supervisors Mar and Haney to the Rules Committee.

• Urban Counties Caucus - All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to Seat 1, therefore, the caucus will not have Board representation.

San Francisco Airport (SFO) Community Roundtable - All Supervisors declined the opportunity to be appointed to the alternate Seat 2.

For all the remaining vacancies, we will poll again in the Spring.

City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors Compensated/ Non-Compensated Positions

Three Supervisors serve on the Executive Committee of the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG). One appointment rotates each two years between the Board and the Mayor. In 2011 the seat is an appointment of the Board. There are three alternate members. The Committee meets about six times a year, usually on the third Thursday of each month at 7:30 p.m. at 101 8th Street in Oakland, next to the Lake Merritt BART Station. Members are each paid \$150 a meeting. Please contact Fred Castro at (415) 464-7913 or you may visit their website: www.abag.ca.gov for scheduled meetings.

One Supervisor sits and serves on the **California Associations of Counties**. CSAC Board Members meet four times in one year: The Member is entitled to receive compensation for CSAC meeting related expenses, limited to \$1,000 per year. An Alternate Member may also be appointed at this time, without a stipend. For more information please contact Geoffrey Neill at 916-327-7500 (x-567).

One Supervisor sits on the City College Financial Assistance Fund Oversight Committee. They shall review City College's implementation of the grant agreement and to prepare an annual public report to the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors, and the Department of Children, Youth, and Their Families, as well as to City College, concerning the implementation of the grant agreement and disbursements from the fund. This Committee meets once every three months in City Hall Rm. 201. For more information, please contact Rebecca Coteza at 415-554-3510.

One Supervisor sits on the **Urban Counties Caucus**. UCC enables the urban counties to pool and coordinate their efforts to pursue legislative action that reflects the needs of the State's most populous areas. One Supervisor sits and serves on the San Francisco International Roundtable as well as one <u>alternate seat which is currently vacant</u>. Board Qualifications:

The San Francisco Bay Conservation & Development Commission SF (BCDC) is a State agency consisting of 27 members, one Board (voting) member appointed by the Board of Supervisors whose district includes within its boundaries lands lying within the San Francisco Bay (Districts 1, 2, 3, 6, and 10). The appointed member selects an alternate who must be confirmed by the Board of Supervisors and must have the same qualifications as the member.

The composition of the members of the Commission is as follows: (a) One (1) member appointed by the Division Engineer, United States Army Engineers, South Pacific Division, from his or her staff; (b) One (1) member appointed by the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency, from his or her staff; (c) One (1) member appointed by the California Secretary of Business and Transportation from his or her staff; (d) One (1) member appointed by the California Director of Finance, from his or her staff; (e) One (1) member appointed by the California Secretary of Resources, from his or her staff; (f) One (1) member appointed by the California State Lands Commission, who shall be a member of that commission or from its staff; (g) One (1) member appointed by the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board, who shall be a member of that board (h) Nine county representatives consisting of one member of the Board of Supervisors representative of each of the nine San Francisco Bay Area counties, appointed by the Board of Supervisors in each county. Each county representative shall be a supervisor representing a supervisorial district which includes within its boundaries lands lying with San Francisco Bay; (i) Four (4) city representatives appointed by the Association of Bay Area Governments from among the residents of the bayside cities in each of the following areas: (1) North Bay--Marin, Sonoma,

Napa and Solano Counties; (2) East Bay-Contra Costa County (west of Pittsburg) and Alameda County north of the southern boundary of Hayward; (3) South Bay--Alameda County south of the southern boundary of Hayward, Santa Clara County, and San Mateo County south of the northern boundary of Redwood City; (4) West Bay--San Mateo County north of the northern boundary of Redwood City, and the City and County of San Francisco. Each city representative shall be an elected city official; (j) Seven (7) representatives of the public, who shall be residents of the San Francisco Bay Area. Five of the representatives shall be appointed by the Governor and their appointments shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate. One of the representatives shall be appointed by the Committee on Rules of the Senate, and one by the Speaker of the Assembly.

The commission shall provide a politically-responsible, democratic process by which the San Francisco Bay and its shoreline can be analyzed, planned, and regulated as a unit. The Commission shall make a continuing review of all the matters referred to in Section 66603 and Section 66651. Powers and duties of the Commission are stated in Section 66600 et seq.

Term of Office: Indefinite (not referenced).

Reports: The Commission has prepared a comprehensive and enforceable plan for the conservation of the water of the bay and the development of its shoreline entitled the San Francisco Bay Plan.

Compensation: Section 66622. In lieu of reimbursement for attendance at commission or committee meetings, or at meetings in an official capacity as a commissioner, each member of the commission or alternate who is not a state or federal employee shall receive a per diem of \$100 per day not to exceed a combined total of four days in any one calendar month.

Sunset Clause: None referenced
