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Resolution authorizing the Purchasing Division of the Office of Contract Administration
to negotiate and enter into a sole source contract with the San Francisco Chronicle to
be the official newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco for the category of
consecutive day official advertising for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002.

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8 WHEREAS, in each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the official 9 newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco for the category of consecutive day 10 official advertising, pursuant to Article IX, Section 2.80-1 and 2.81 of the San Francisco 11 Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, invitations to bids were published and no bids were received for consecutive day official advertising; there are not qualified daily newspapers that are in compliance with Chapter 12B of the Administrative Code, and consecutive day official advertising is essential to the City and its residents; now therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Division of the Office of Contract Administration is 17 hereby authorized to negotiate a sole source contract for consecutive day official advertising 18 with the San Francisco Chronicle, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City and 19 County of San Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic news and intelligence of 20 a general character, having a bona fide circulation of at least 50,000 copies per calendar 21 week, printed in the City and County on three or more days in a calendar week, to be an 22 official newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco, commencing upon execution of 23 an official contract, for the publication of all official advertising of the City and County of San Francisco which is required by law to be published on two or more consecutive days, and all 24 25 official advertising of the City and County which is required to be published in accordance with

1	the provisions of Section 2.103 of the Charter as they relate to special meetings of the Board
2	of Supervisors and its standing or special committees; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Division of the Office of Contract
4	Administration is hereby authorized to execute a contract upon completing negotiations with
5	the San Francisco Chronicle and said contract must be at the best terms and pricing for the
6	City and in accordance with all applicable contracting requirements of the City and County of
7	San Francisco.
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
