21	WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available funds on program		
22	expenditures by not including indirect costs in the subcontract budget; now, therefore, be it		
23	RESOLVED, That SFDPH, CSP is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a		
24	subcontract agreement in the amount of \$18,450 with UCSF, the primary contractor for		

services under the "Integrated Family Services Program"; and, be it
