4	Resolution condemning negative stereotyping of Asian-Americans perpetuated by
5	recent KPIX coverage and their unfair, unbalanced and irresponsible series on
6	unsanitary conditions inside Chinese restaurants in San Francisco, and urging KPIX to
7	immediately cease airing the series until KPIX pursues fair and balanced coverage of
	this issue.

9	WHEREAS, San Francisco is home to over 6,000 restaurants and food
10	establishments; and,
11	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) inspects every
12 13	restaurant in San Francisco multiple times a year and issues several citations to a broad
14	range of eating and drinking establishments; and,
15	WHEREAS, The vast majority of these violations are corrected within 48 hours of
16	DPH's initial citation; and,
17	WHEREAS, Channel 5 KPIX has unfairly targeted restaurants owned and operated by
18	members of the Chinese community for its series on unsanitary and unhealthy conditions
	inside restaurant kitchens, and specifically every single restaurant of the seven restaurants
19	highlighted for the report are owned by local Chinese American residents; now, therefore, be
20	it
21	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors is gravely concerned about
22	unfair coverage and the negative stereotypes perpetuated against Chinese Americans in
23	
24	KPIX's recent series on health conditions in local restaurants; and, be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors strongly urges
2	KPIX to immediately cease airing this sensationalized and irresponsible series of reports until
3	KPIX pursues fair and balanced coverage of this issue.
