6 **Motion requesting that the Clerk of the Board, in consultation with the Office of the**
7 **Secretary of State, and the Elections Commission, enter into an agreement with AtPac**
8 **to provide a retally of the ballots cast in the November 7, 2000 Consolidated Municipal**
9 **Election and recanvass ballots cast in a random sample of precincts in the November**
10 **6, 2001 Consolidated Municipal Election.**

11 WHEREAS, The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, in consultation with the Office of
12 the Secretary of State, issued a Request for Proposal for an audit of the November 7, 2000
13 and November 6, 2001 Consolidated Municipal Elections; and,

14 WHEREAS, AtPac was the sole respondent to the Request for Proposal (RFP),
15 specifically addressing the tasks delineated in the proposal; and

16 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors further requested the Clerk of the Board, in
17 consultation with the Office of the Secretary of State, to submit to the Board of Supervisors for
18 approval any RFP submitted by potential auditors that would define the scope of duties to be
19 performed, and the costs for performing the work for both the November 2000 and November
20 2001 elections; now, therefore, be it

21 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
22 recommends that the Clerk of the Board, in consultation with the Office of the Secretary of
23 State, enter into a contract with AtPac to perform the audits delineated in their proposal; and

1 FURTHER MOVED, that the City Controller prepare a supplemental appropriation in an
2 amount not to exceed \$275,405; and be it

3 FURTHER MOVED, that the Department of Elections and the Office of the Secretary of
4 State provide the necessary resources to assist AtPac in their audit of the November 7, 2000
5 and November 6, 2001.
