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8	WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco adopted a new
9	charter effective July 1, 1996 which in Section 10.104(15) incorporates the provisions of
10	Proposition "J" adopted November 1976, allowing City Departments to contract with private
11	companies for specific services; and
12	WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on June 25, 2002, that the services involved in
13	the management and operation of an Airport Information Booth Program at San Francisco
14	International Airport can be practically performed by Polaris Research and Development at a
15	lower cost to the City and County of San Francisco than if such services were performed by
16	employees of the City and County of San Francisco; now therefore, be it,
17	RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104(15) of the Charter, this Board of
18	Supervisors hereby approves said Controller's Certification.
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
