[Enhance the safety of firefighters by utilizing 800 MHz portable radios and to transition from CFIRS to NFIRS reporting as required by the State Fire Marshal's Office.]

Resolution retroactively authorizing the San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) to accept and expend a new grant in the amount of $\$ 409,633$ from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to acquire $\mathbf{8 0 0} \mathbf{~ M H z}$ portable radios for all firefighters working in suppression and to transfer from the California Fire Incident Reporting System (CFIRS) to the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS), for the period of September 15, 2002 through September 14, 2003.

WHEREAS, SFFD has applied for and been awarded a grant from FEMA in the amount of $\$ 409,633$ to purchase $141-800 \mathrm{MHz}$ radios for all suppression personnel in the Fire Department and to transfer from CFIRS to NFIRS reporting as statutorily required by the State Fire Marshal's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFFD is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of $\$ 409,633$ from FEMA.
