5 6	WHEREAS, San Francisco industries and residents alike have been affected by the
7 8	national and local economic slowdown; and, WHEREAS, San Francisco has an office vacancy rate of greater than 25 percent; and, WHEREAS, the hotel industry has seen a 14.9% drop in visitors in 2001 and a drop in
9 10	revenues of 17.2%; and,
11 12	WHEREAS, overall tourist spending was down 14.6% last year; and, WHEREAS, the overall effect of the slowing economy has diminished the tax base for
13	City and County of San Francisco and created a budget shortfall; and, WHEREAS, future city-provided and city-funded services may be at stake if an
14 15	economic slowdown continues; and, WHEREAS, San Francisco communities, businesses and industry, educational
16 17	organizations, residents, commuters, labor organizations, religious organizations, local government, city provided services, and arts and non-profit organizations all have a stake in
18 19	San Francisco's long-term planning and growth issues and a strong San Francisco economy;
20 21	and, WHEREAS, issues of economic development and growth have on occasion, polarized
22	some communities and organizations; WHEREAS, the City of Chicago and the surrounding metropolis participated in a long-
232425	term plan on growth called Chicago Metropolis 2020 that was inclusive of stakeholders across the region; now, therefore be it

2	hereby supports the gathering of those individuals and organizations that have a stake in San
3	Francisco's future for an inclusive conference in the year 2003 on the local economy.
