WHEREAS, Garfield Beach CVS, LLC is seeking the transfer of a Type-21 off-sale general beer, wine, and distilled spirits license for a proposed CVS Pharmacy located at 500 Pine Street (District 3); and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed seven protests and zero letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. each day of the week; 2) no distilled spirits shall be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 600 milliliters; 3) petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on the most-recently-

certified ABC-253; 4) the following alcoholic beverages shall not be sold in quantities of fewer than three (3) individual containers per sale: a) beer, including malt beverages and malt liquor products, in containers of 40 ounces or less; b) pre-mixed wine products commonly known as "wine coolers;" and c) pre-mixed distilled spirits-based cocktails; and 5) no wine shall be sold with an alcohol content of greater than 15% by volume; and

WHEREAS, The site is located in an area with an undue concentration of liquor licenses; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the transfer of a Type-21 off-sale general beer, wine, and distilled spirits license to Garfield Beach CVS, doing business as CVS Pharmacy, located at 500 Pine Street (District 3), will not serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby respectfully requests that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control deny the issuance of the license.
