recently-certified ABC-253; and 3) the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is prohibited; and

WHEREAS, The site is located in an area with an undue concentration of liquor licenses; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the issuance of a Type-42 on-sale beer and wine public premises liquor license to 1 and 8 Inc., doing business as the Museum of Ice Cream, located at 1 Grant Avenue (District 3), will not serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby respectfully requests that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control deny the issuance of the license.
