12	Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference		
13	herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter		
14	dated 2003, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent		
15	with the General Plan and Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of

17	Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No, a

1	Section 3. JC Decaux San Francisco, Inc., the project sponsor who proposes to		
2	undertake the sidewalk construction to implement the sidewalk width changes, is required to		
3	make arrangements with public utilities and City Departments concerning relocation,		
4	modification, or both of facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas. Any necessary		
5	relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County		
6	San Francisco.
