On February 6, 2019, the San Francisco Historic Preservation Commission (hereinafter "HPC") conducted a duly noticed public hearing at a regularly scheduled meeting to consider a recommendation for amending the landmark designation of 906 Broadway, known historically as Our Lady of Guadalupe Church (Landmark No. 204), to the Board of Supervisors. At the hearing, the HPC voted to approve a resolution to recommend landmark designation amendment pursuant to Article 10 of the Planning Code.

The proposed amendments are not defined as a project under CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c) and 15378 because they do not result in a physical change in the environment.
