6	the SFDPH portion for "San Francisco HIV Vaccine Clinical Trials", a unit of the HIV		
7	Vaccine Trials Network (HVTN); for the period of June 1, 2003 to May 31, 2004.

9	WHEREAS, PHFE has received fourth year funding from the National Institutes of		
10	Health to continue participation by the SFDPH in the San Francisco HIV Vaccine Clinical		
11	Trials project; and,		
12	WHEREAS, PHFE has requested that the SFDPH enter into a subcontract agreement		
13	to participate in this project by continuing to provide scientific expertise; development of		
14	community outreach; conducting Phases I, II, IIB, and III HIV vaccine trials in San Francisco;		
15	and maximizing enrollment of high-risk participants; and,		
16	WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse the SFDPH in the amount of		
17	\$405,101under the terms of this subcontract; and,		
18	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds PHFE requires the SFDPH to enter		
19	into an agreement (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
20	Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this		
21	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
22	WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$55,876;		
23	and,		
24	WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors		
25	because we did not receive the subcontract from PHFE until June 30, 2003; and,		

1	WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds		
2	may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually		
3	considered to be routine items, and the resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure		
4	of grant funding; now, therefore, be it		
5	RESOLVED, That the SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a		
6	subcontract agreement in the amount of \$405,101 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be		
7	it		
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
9	Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions		
11	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when		
12	the agreement expires.
