16	WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic was awarded \$199,204 on June 2,		
17	2003, in OTS grant funding for the period from October 1, 2003 to December 31, 2005, to		
18	work with school groups to institute a comprehensive program of education, outreach, and		
19	enforcement to complement the engineering activities (Safe Routes to School Projects and		
20			
21	School Area Traffic Calming) that the Department of Parking and Traffic is already		
22	undertaking to address traffic safety concerns around elementary schools; and,		
23	WHEREAS, School officials, parents and surrounding local community are		
24	collaborative supporters of this proposal and specific safety outreach efforts and
