13	WHEREAS, PHFE, and SFDPH have agreed to enter into a subcontract agreement to		
14	participate in this project; and,		
15	WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$100,929 from this award under the terms of this subcontract agreement; and, WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, PHFE requires SFDPH to enter into

19	Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this		
20	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
21	WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$13,921;

22	WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors		
23	because we did not receive the subcontract until September 24, 2003; and,

2	may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually		
3	considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure

5	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract		
6	agreement in the amount of \$100,929 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be it		
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
8	Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
10	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
11	the agreement expires.
