4	to require the Mayor to inform the Board of Supervisors in writing when leaving the
5	state for more than 24 hours, to require the Mayor to designate Acting Mayors in
6	writing and inform the Clerk of the Board of such designations, to require the Mayor to
7	notify the Clerk of the Board upon returning to the state, to require Acting Mayors to
8	report on any official actions taken, and to require members of the Board to receive
9	training on emergency operations.

13	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
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15	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
16	Section 2A.11, to read as follows:
17	SEC. 2A.11. ACTING MAYORS.
18	(a) Before leaving the state for more than 24 hours, the Mayor shall notify the Clerk of the
19	Board of Supervisors in writing of the anticipated length of the trip, the general itinerary, and the
20	general purpose of the trip. The Mayor shall provide the same information to the Chief of Police, the
21	Chief of the Fire Department, the Director of Public Health, and the Director of Emergency Services.
22	(b) The Mayor's designation of an Acting Mayor pursuant to Charter Section 3.100(12) shall
23	be in writing and shall be delivered to the member of the Board of Supervisors so designated and to the
24	Clerk of the Board. The Clerk shall post the information promptly on the City's web site. The Mayor
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1	shall provide the same information to the President of the Board of Supervisors, the Chief of Police, the
2	Chief of the Fire Department, the Director of Public Health, and the Director of Emergency Services.
3	(c) The Mayor shall promptly give written notice to the Clerk of the Board upon returning to
4	the state, but the Mayor's failure to give such notice shall not affect his or her resumption of office as
5	<u>Mayor.</u>
6	(d) Upon the Mayor's return to the City, an Acting Mayor shall, as soon as is reasonably
7	possible, provide to the Mayor and the Clerk of the Board a written report of any official actions taken.
8	(e) In order to enable them to function effectively as Acting Mayor in the case of an emergency,
9	all members of the Board of Supervisors shall attend training at least twice a year on the City's
10	Emergency Operations Plan, to be presented by the Office of Emergency Services.
