

1 [Appointment – Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Forces]

3 **Resolution appointing Scott Hoshida, term ending December 12, 2004, to the Childhood**
4 **Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Force; residency requirement waived.**

6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
7 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the
8 Childhood Nutrition & Physical Nutrition Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution
9 522-03, for the term specified:

10 Scott Hoshida (residency requirement waived), new position, seat 14, must belong to a
11 foundation or philanthropic organization with an interest in physical activity and healthy eating,
12 for the unexpired portion of a one year term ending December 12, 2004; and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 14 1. The membership of the Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Force has a
15 goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco;
16 2. Applicant Scott Hoshida, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco,
17 is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the
18 Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Force;
19 3. The Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Force has attempted to fill the
20 position, for which Scott Hoshida was nominated, with an individual who is a City
21 resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has
22 been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Scott
23 Hoshida is qualified to serve on the Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task
24 Force;

1 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
2 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the
3 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
4 willing to serve on the Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Force at this
5 time; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency
7 requirement for Scott Hoshida, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to
8 serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)
9 appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the
10 Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
