10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
11	Section 1. The Sar	n Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending Section	
12	33.3.2, to read as follows:		
13	Sec. 33.3.2 TRUCK LOADING ZONES IN PARKING BAYS ALONG MARKET		
14	STREET BETWEEN STEUART STREET AND OCTAVIA STREET.		
15	The Board of Supervisors hereby determines that the establishment of special truck		
16	loading zones for trucks with six or more wheels within the parking bays along Market Street		
17	between Steuart Street and Octavia Street is reasonably necessary and desirable for the		
18	regulation of traffic, wherein stopping, standing or parking at any time on any day, including		
19	Saturday and Sunday, shall be limited to trucks for the purpose of loading or unloading freight		
20	for a period not in excess of 30 minutes, except that the Board of Supervisors may, by resolution		
21	Department of Parking and Traffic may, following a public hearing, designate a tour bus loading		
22	zone <u>s, loading zones for commercial vehicles with less than six wheels or parking meters</u> within said		
23	bays or within a portion of said bays. The special truck loading zones shall be posted with		
24	signs with the message "TRUCKS WITH SIX OR MORE WHEELS ONLY."
