3	Resolution urging the Recreation and Park Department and the Arts Commission, in
4	consultation with the City Attorney's Office, the Port Commission and the Department
5	of Public Works, to consider the possible removal and replacement of the Vaillancourt
6	Fountain from Justin Herman Plaza with alternative works of art or public areas and to
7	explore possible funding sources for such removal and replacement.

9	WHEREAS, The Vaillancourt Fountain at Justin Herman Plaza and Four Embarcadero
10	Center has was built in 1971 by French-Canadian sculptor Armand Vaillancourt on land
11	cleared for the Embarcadero Freeway and BART;
12	WHEREAS, The Fountain is built on the site of former hotels and bars in an area once
13	well populated by seamen and was designed to release thousands of gallons of water from its
14	openings;
15	WHEREAS, Although the Fountain originally operated in the manner in which the Artist
16	and community intended, the City has had to turn off the Fountain for an indefinite period of
17	time because the Fountain costs approximately \$200,000 a year to run and requires over a
18	\$100,000 of repairs before it can be turned back on;
19	WHEREAS, The City has been unable to raise sufficient funds to operate and repair
20	the Fountain;
21	WHEREAS; Since its installation in 1971, the Fountain has become an attractive
22	nuisance to the public and a risk to the public health and safety;
23	WHEREAS, Waterfront business owners have expressed concerns over the negative
24	impact that the Fountain is having in Justin Herman Plaza;
25	

WHEREAS, the City is committed to notifying Mr. Vaillancourt and any interested arts
organizations of any potential alternative disposition of the Fountain; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby urges the Recreation and Park
Department and the Arts Commission, in consultation with the City Attorney's Office, the Port
Commission and the Department of Public Works, to consider the possible removal and
replacement of the Vaillancourt Fountain from Justin Herman Plaza with alternative works of
art or public areas and to explore possible funding sources for such removal and replacement.
