7 WHEREAS, **William Breall** received his medical degree from Oregon Health Sciences  
8 University at the University of Oregon in 1954, and then completed his residency at the  
9 University of California, Mt. Zion Medical Center;; and

10 WHEREAS, In the capacity of Base Hospital Cardiologist at Sandia Base, NM, **William**  
11 **Breall** served two years in the United States Army; and

12 WHEREAS, by teaching at UCSF, Mt. Zion, **William Breall** helped educate the medical  
13 field in the area of heart damages; and

14 WHEREAS, **William Breall** received the Award for Outstanding Resident in Internal  
15 Medicine at UCSF, Mt. Zion in both 1961 and 1962; and,

16 WHEREAS, **William Breall** has participated in several research projects, including  
17 studies investigating behavior modifications and the dangers of internal occupational injuries;

19 WHEREAS, **William Breall** has published numerous articles, research papers,  
20 lectures, and a monthly column for the California Workers' Compensation Enquirer, entitled,  
21 "What You Always Wanted to Know about the Heart and Were Too Embarrassed to Ask; and,

22 WHEREAS, through his dedicated work on several public service boards, **William**  
23 **Breall** has promoted Jewish Community values and cultural enrichment; now, therefore, be it;
