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1	Conditions: (1) Petitioner shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the
2	area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; (2) Sales and service of
3	alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
4	each day of the week; (3) Petitioner shall regularly police the area under their control in
5	an effort to prevent the loitering of persons about the premises; (4) Petitioner shall offer
6	for sale only those beers, wines and distilled spirits manufactured outside the United
7	States; (5) Petitioner shall stock and offer for sale a substantial assortment of food
8	and/or merchandise commonly associated with and sold to persons in the Korean
9	community; (6) The quarterly gross sales of alcoholic beverages shall not exceed the
10	gross sales of food during the same period. The licensee shall at all times maintain
11	records which reflect separately the gross sales of food and the gross sales of alcoholic
12	beverages of the licensed business. Said records shall be kept no less frequently than
13	on a quarterly basis and shall be made available to the Department of Alcoholic
14	Beverage Control on demand.
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
