Notwithstanding the provisions of the annual salary ordinance or other local law, no 10 new or vacant position may be filled while this ordinance is in effect, except for those positions where 11 the Mayor determines that: 12 (i) The position is required for public safety or emergency operations, including public health 13 emergencies; or, 14 *(ii) The position is required by law; or.* 15 (iii) Filling the position would result in a net increase in revenues, or would be more cost-16 effective than performing the work involved in another manner or foregoing performance 17 of the work. 18 The Controller shall report to the Board of Supervisors each month on the fiscal impact of the 19 *Mayor's decision to fill any such positions.
