8	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
9	
10	Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the annual salary ordinance or other local law, no
11	new or vacant position may be filled while this ordinance is in effect, except for those positions where
12	the Mayor determines that:
13	(i) The position is required for public safety or emergency operations, including public health
14	emergencies; or,
15	(ii) The position is required by law; or,
16	(iii) Filling the position would result in a net increase in revenues, or would be more cost-
17	effective than performing the work involved in another manner or foregoing performance
18	of the work.
19	The Controller shall report to the Board of Supervisors each month on the fiscal impact of the
20	Mayor's decision to fill any such positions. The Controller shall address the fiscal impact of the
21	positions filled in the current budget year and the anticipated fiscal impact in the upcoming budget
22	<u>year.</u>
23	
24	Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 shall not apply to enterprise or non-General Fund
25	departments.
