	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, UCSF,UARP requires the				
15	to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the				
16	Board of Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of				
17	this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and, WHEREAS,The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$6,788; and,

19	WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors				
20	because the Department did not receive the UCSF, UARP subcontract until February 3, 2004;				
21	and,				
22	WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds				
23	may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually

1	considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
2	of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

3	RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and		
4	expend a grant in the amount of \$106,788 from UCSF,UARP; and, be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept and		
6	expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement		
7	pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it		
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
9	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
11	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
12	the agreement expires.
