Resolution retroactively approving the Sixth Amendment to the Revenue Agreement between Public Works and JC Decaux San Francisco, LLC, for the Automatic Public Toilet and Public Service Kiosk Program extending the contract term by 90 days,

[Revenue Agreement Amendment - JC Decaux San Francisco, LLC - Extending Term to April

changing the termination date from January 25, 2019, to April 25, 2019.

WHEREAS, Public Works entered into an agreement with JC Decaux San Francisco, LLC for a public toilet and public service kiosk pilot program, with an effective date of August 2, 1994; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved a First Amended and Restated Automatic Public Toilet and Public Service Kiosk Agreement ("JC Decaux Agreement") on December 7, 1998, which expanded the program beyond the trial phase with a term ending on October 17, 2016; and

WHEREAS, On December 14, 2015, the parties executed a first amendment to the JC Decaux Agreement to allow installation of temporary personal wireless services in the kiosks; and

WHEREAS, On October 28, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved a second amendment to the JC Decaux Agreement to extend the term of the agreement to October 17, 2017; and

WHEREAS, On November 14, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved a third amendment to the JC Decaux Agreement to extend the term of the agreement to February 14, 2018; and

WHEREAS, On April 17, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved a fourth amendment to the JC Decaux Agreement to extend the term of the agreement to October 12, 2018; and

WHEREAS, On November 13, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved a fifth amendment to the JC Decaux Agreement to extend the term of the agreement to January 25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The JC Decaux Agreement, the First Amendment to the Agreement, Second Amendment to the Agreement, the Third Amendment to the Agreement, the Fourth Amendment to the Agreement, and the Fifth Amendment to the Agreement are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in Files No. 981599, 161019, 170994, 180135, and 180964 respectively and which are hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, Public Works needs additional time to complete contract negotiations based on the newly approved design that has met all City design and review requirements for proposed new public toilets and public service kiosks as of the December 2018; and

WHEREAS, Public Works cannot complete the negotiations for the new Toilets and Kiosks before the current agreement expires; and

WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(a) requires that amendments to contracts that when entered into had anticipated revenues of \$1,000,000 or more be approved by the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors approves the Sixth Amendment to the JC Decaux Agreement, which extends the term of the JC Decaux Agreement by 90 days to April 25, 2019; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the amendment being fully executed by all parties, Public Works shall provide the final amendment to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.

Sixth Amendment to Agreement

THIS SIXTH AMENDMENT (this "Amendment") is made as of January 11, 2019, in San Francisco, California, by and between **JC Decaux San Francisco**, **LLC** ("Contractor"), and the City and County of San Francisco, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting by and through its Director of Public Works.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, City and Contractor have entered into the Agreement as amended (as defined below); and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor desire to modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein to extend the contract duration by 90 days;

NOW, THEREFORE, Contractor and the City agree as follows:

- 1. **Definitions.** The following definitions shall apply to this Amendment:
- **1a. Agreement.** The term "Agreement" shall mean the Agreement dated August 2, 1994, between Contractor and City, as amended by the

First Amended and Restated Agreement, approved by the Board of Supervisors on December 7, 1998; and

First Amendment to the Agreement, dated December 14, 2015; and Second Amendment to the Agreement, dated October 28, 2016; and Third Amendment to the Agreement, dated September 12, 2017; and Fourth Amendment to the Agreement, dated February 5, 2018; and Fifth Amendment to the Agreement, dated September 5, 2018

- **1b. Other Terms.** Terms used and not defined in this Amendment shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Agreement.
- **2. Modifications to the Agreement.** The Agreement is hereby modified as follows:
- **2a. Section 1.03.** *Section 1.03. Term of Agreement* of the Agreement currently reads as follows:

This Agreement shall commence as of the Original Effective Date and shall continue, subject to the terms of this Agreement regarding termination, to 11:59 p.m. on January 25, 2019.

Such section is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

This Agreement shall commence as of the Original Effective Date and shall continue, subject to the terms of this Agreement regarding termination, to 11:59 p.m. on April 25, 2019.
