17	(1) All permanent employees of the City and County of San Francisco whose normal
18	work week at the time of inclusion is the system in not less than twenty (20) hours;
19	(2) All regularly scheduled provisional employees of the City and County of San
20	Francisco whose normal work week at the time of inclusion in the system is not less than
21	twenty (20) hours;
22	(3) All other employees of the City and County of San Francisco, including "as needed"
23	employees, who have worked one thousand and forty hours (1040) in any consecutive twelve
24	(12) month period and whose normal work week at the time of inclusion in the system is not
25	less than twenty (20) hours.
