11 Scott Spertzel, seat 2, succeeding himself, term expired, must have a minimum of five
12 years professional experience in the State of California as one of the following: certified public
13 accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; or a property appraiser
14 accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, certified by the Office of Real
15 Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board of Equalization, for a three-year term ending
16 September 6, 2021.

17 Edward Campana, seat 5, succeeding himself, term expired, must have a minimum of
18 five years professional experience in the State of California as one of the following: certified
19 public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; or a property
20 appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, certified by the
21 Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board of Equalization, for a three-
22 year term ending September 6, 2021.

23 Kristine Nelson, seat 6 (Alternate Member), succeeding Scott Spertzel, term expired,
24 must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as one of
25 the following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker;

1 attorney; or a property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional
2 organization, certified by the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board
3 of Equalization, for a three-year term ending September 6, 2021.

4 Paul Bellar, seat 8 (Alternate Member), succeeding Donna Crowder, resigned, must
5 have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as one of the
6 following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker;
7 attorney; or a property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional
8 organization, certified by the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board
9 of Equalization, for a three-year term ending September 6, 2021.

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
