8	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
9	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by deleting		
10	Section 10.100-114, as follows:		
11	Sec. 10.100-114 MAYOR'S NEIGHBORHOOD BEAUTIFICATION AND GRAFFITI CLEAN-		
12	<i>UP FUND.</i>		
13	(a) Findings. The proliferation of graffiti on public buildings and other public property has		
14	created a blight which offends both citizens of and visitors to San Francisco. The removal of such		
15	graffiti will enhance the beauty of the City in which we live and will encourage others to visit and to		
16	relocate here. Removal will thus both reflect and renew our civic pride and contribute to our economic		
17	viability. Providing a source of funds for the promotion of neighborhood beautification projects will		
18	support the efforts of local residents and businesses to improve the quality of life for San Francisco		
19	residents and the local economy, and assist in reducing the amount of graffiti in San Francisco.		
20	(b) Statement of Intent. The Board of Supervisors wishes to address the above concerns by		
21	establishing a neighborhood beautification and graffiti clean-up fund which will promote neighborhoo		
22	beautification projects, including projects designed to improve the environmental quality of		
23	neighborhoods, and financ	re the clean-up of graffiti on public property.	
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1	(c) Establishment of Fund. The Mayor's Neighborhood Beautification and Graffiti Clean-Up		
2	Fund is established as a category four fund for the purpose of receiving all donations or grants of		
3	money which may be collected by the City and County of San Francisco for the purposes noted in (b).		
4	(d) Use of Fund. The fund shall be used exclusively for the purposes enumerated in (b),		
5	provided that such expenditures shall include reimbursement to City and County departments for		
6	expenses incurred in the administration of the fund.		
7	(e) Administration of Fund. The Mayor shall have the following duties in regard to		
8	administration of the fund:		
9	1. The Mayor, or his or her designee, shall be responsible for the administration of the		
10	Neighborhood Beautification and Graffiti Clean-Up Fund, and shall have all such authority as may be		
11	reasonably necessary to carry out those responsibilities.		
12	2. The Mayor shall promulgate such rules and regulations as he or she may deem appropriate		
13	to carry out the provisions of this section. Before issuing or amending any rules and regulations, the		
14	Mayor shall provide a 30-day public comment period by providing published notice in an official		
15	newspaper of general circulation in the City of the intent to issue or amend the rules and regulations.		
16	The rules and regulations shall be approved by resolution of the Board of Supervisors. Such rules and		
17	regulations shall include, but not be limited to, the qualifications of applicants and factors to be		
18	considered in the award of grants to fund programs to help remove graffiti and promote neighborhood		
19	beautification projects, including preference for the following projects: youth programs and		
20	innovation, projects that are neighborhood generated, and projects designed to benefit areas of San		
21	Francisco that are economically disadvantaged.		
22	3. The Mayor shall submit a semiannual report to the Board of Supervisors setting forth an		
23	accounting of the amounts disbursed and the uses for which said funds were made.
