7	WHEREAS, Nearly 35,000 people are killed every year in the United States leaving
8	family members, friends and neighbors grieving; and
9	WHEREAS, Survivors of homicide victims are confronted with overwhelming
10	challenges to overcome, and often cling to simple memories to fill the void the lost of a
11	relative or friend creates; and
12	WHEREAS, Given the tragedy of September 11, 2001, this observance is of greater
13	importance because our institutions and our society are uncomfortable dealing with survivors
14	of homicide victims; and,
15	WHEREAS, This yearly observance provides a platform where, as a city, we can learn
16	how to better address families who have been brutally impacted by violence and to support
17	the efforts of survivors who are informing our violence prevention and peacemaking
18	movement; and,
19	WHEREAS, November 20 th to December 20 th is a fitting time for this awareness
20	because during the holiday season, survivors often experience overwhelming feelings of loss,
21	grief and despair; and,
22	WHEREAS, The awareness will help to encourage survivors of homicide victims to
23	associate the holidays season as a time to feel supported and strengthened for what they
24	have survived through instead of resenting this season because of their losses; now,
25	therefore, be it

1	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
2	does hereby proclaim November 20 to December 20 th of each year as Survivor of Homicide
3	Victims awareness Month" in the City and County of San Francisco.
