4 (1) Monitoring Conditions of Approval and Mitigation Measures Established 5 Pursuant to an Environmental Document or a Public Hearing by the Planning Commission or 6 Zoning Administrator for All Approved Applications in Chapter 31 of the Administrative Code 7 or Sections 352(a) and (i), 353(a) and (b) and 355: \$71 for first hour of staff time plus time and 8 materials as set forth in Section 350(c). This fee shall supersede project monitoring fees 9 under prior Section 352(g)(1) unless required as a condition of approval by the Planning 10 Commission.
