5	to complete a study on Ocean Beach necessary for planned implementation of wave-
6	generated power in San Francisco

8	WHEREAS, San Francisco has a world-class tidal power resource and an off-shore
9	wave-generation capability, and
10	WHEREAS, San Franciscans have voted to support renewable energy projects
11	including wave-generated power, solar power, and tidal power through revenue bonds to be
12	used to finance such projects; and
13	WHEREAS, Such revenue bonds can not be issued until certain preliminary siting
14	studies are completed and financed, without which implementation of such technologies will
15	never occur; and
16	WHEREAS, Implementation of new energy generating technologies such as these has
17	never happened without government support and financing; and
18	WHEREAS, The State of California has urged the development of new energy
19	technologies but has failed to make good on its promises to follow through with adequate
20	funding; and
21	WHEREAS, San Francisco is currently being offered a leadership role in conjunction
22	with the City of Oakland, to fund a research project that will pave the way for implementation
23	of wave generated power at Ocean Beach; and
24	WHEREAS, Such a study, if undertaken at a later date will cost the City of San
25	Francisco more to implement; and

2	to share data produced from this study for the benefit of their own offshore wave generation
3	project; therefore be it
4

6	the amount of \$30,000 with the City of Oakland (contributing an additional \$10,000) in order
7	for both parties to make possible EPRI's phase one evaluation of site and technology for
8	renewable energy wave generation of Ocean Beach, San Francisco.
