12	WHEREAS, The Director of Administrative Services has previously sought and
13	received approval of the Board of Supervisors to contract with the Moscone Joint Venture
14	under the provision of Proposition J and now wishes to fund the contract for the management,
15	operation and maintenance services for 2004-05; and,
16	WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on August 2, 2004 that said services can be
17	performed at a lower cost to the City than by employees of the City and County; now,
18	therefore, be it
19	RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's
20	certification and approval that the Director of Administrative Services may contract for
21	management, operation and maintenance services for Bill Graham Civic Auditorium and the
22	Moscone Center.
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
