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3	Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public
4	premises license from One Sansome Street to 580 Sutter Street (District 6) to
5	Clint Worden for Plan B Bar Inc. will serve the public convenience and necessity
6	of the people of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with section
7	23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, with conditions.

9	WHEREAS, Clint Worden is seeking transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public
10	premises license for Plan B Bar Inc., located at 580 Sutter Street; and,
11	WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
12	zoned; and,
13	WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license
14	application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it
15	RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
16	and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
17	Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 48
18	on-sale general public premises license from One Sansome Street to 580 Sutter Street
19	(District 6) for Clint Worden for Plan B Bar Inc. will serve the public convenience and
20	necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco, with conditions.
21	Conditions: (1) The premises shall be maintained as a bona fide art gallery (a
22	room or building devoted to the exhibition of works of art) with the sale of beer, wine and
23	distilled spirits as an incidental part of the operation. The premises shall be used for no
24	other purpose.

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(2) The petitioner(s) shall stock and offer for sale a substantial assortment of art
 and/or merchandise commonly associated with and sold to persons in the community.

3 (3) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly4 prohibited.

5 (4) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining the area adjacent to the
6 premises over which they have control free of litter and loitering.

- 7 (5) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee.
- 8 (6) At any time the premises are providing live entertainment, the petitioner(s)

9 shall provide security personnel that shall maintain order therein and prevent any

10 activity which would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of their property by nearby

residents. Said personnel shall be clothed in such a manner as to be readily identifiableas security.

13 (7) The petitioner(s) shall not display any magazine, video, printed or painted14 material which contains pictures depicting:

15 *Acts or simulated acts or sexual acts, which are prohibited by law.

*Any person being touched, caressed or fondled in a manner prohibited bylaw.

18 *Scenes wherein artificial devices or inanimate objects are employed to

- depict, or drawings are employed to portray, any other prohibited activitiesdescribed above.
- 21 (8) No pool or billiard tables may be maintained on the premises.

(9) There shall be no coin operated games or video machines upon the premisesat anytime.

24 (10) There shall be no exterior advertising or signs of any type, including

advertising to the exterior from within, promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic

beverages. Interior displays of alcoholic beverages or signs which are clearly visible to the exterior shall constitute a violation of this condition. (11) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday and 12:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight) Sunday and Monday.
