1	[Traffic Regulation – 14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenues Temporary Street Closure.]
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3	Resolution enacting "Temporary Street Closure to Vehicular Traffic" regulations on
4	portions of 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, north of Lake Street at the 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and
5	15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue Gates, until December 1, 2005 for public safety reasons; making
6	environmental findings; and providing for monitoring of local intersections.
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8	WHEREAS, 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, north of Lake Street at the 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue Gate, is currently
9	closed to vehicular traffic into and out of the Presidio; and
10	WHEREAS, 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue north of Lake Street is currently open to northbound and
11	southbound vehicular traffic into and out of the Presidio; and,
12	WHEREAS, the amount of automobile traffic traveling along the blocks of 14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup>
13	Avenues north of Lake Street and south of the Presidio has been minimal due to the lack of
14	development in the Presidio; and,
15	WHEREAS, the Planning Department has determined that the action contemplated in
16	this Resolution is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
17	Public Resources Code section 21000, et seq.) Said determination is on file with the Clerk of
18	the Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by reference; and,
19	WHEREAS, currently, the main traffic on 14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenues north of Lake Street
20	and into and out of the Presidio is bicyclists and pedestrians; and,
21	WHEREAS, the blocks of 14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenues north of Lake Street and south of the
22	Presidio are quiet, residential neighborhoods which allow children to play without a significant
23	fear of pedestrian injury or death; and,
24	WHEREAS, the Presidio Trust is proposing to rehabilitate and reuse buildings at the
25	former Public Health Service Hospital (PHSH) in the Presidio to provide new residential

1	housing units. The location for the new residential development is directly adjacent to the
2	Richmond – Park Presidio neighborhood that encompasses the blocks of 14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup>
3	Avenues north of Lake Street and just south of the Presidio; and,
4	WHEREAS, the Presidio Trust has proposed a development plan that would add 350
5	units of new residential housing at the PHSH site; and,
6	WHEREAS, the Presidio Trust has proposed to use 14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenues as primary
7	entry and exit points for vehicular traffic associated with the residential uses of their
8	development plan; and,
9	WHEREAS, the residents of the Richmond – Park Presidio neighborhood are
10	concerned about the impact on public safety and the protection of bicyclists, pedestrians, and
11	children if there is a significant increase in vehicular traffic as a result of the Presidio Trust's
12	development of the PHSH site; and,
13	WHEREAS, residents of the Richmond – Park Presidio neighborhood have suggested
14	several alternatives that would mitigate the likely impacts of Presidio development plans
15	proposed for the site, but the Presidio Trust continues to favor the most intense development
16	proposal while rejecting alternatives to reroute traffic proposed by the neighborhood; and,
17	WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code section 21101(e) provides that the City may
18	temporarily close a portion of any street when such closure is necessary for the safety and
19	protection of persons who will use the street during the temporary closure; and,
20	WHEREAS, it is necessary to temporarily close portions of 14th and 15th Avenues,
21	north of Lake Street at the 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue Gates, for the safety and protection
22	of persons who will use the closed portion of these streets during the temporary closure; and,
23	WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic (DPT) will monitor local
24	intersections during the term of this closure to assess vehicular and pedestrian impacts; and,

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1	WHEREAS, should DPT find the intersection levels of service substantially deteriorate
2	during this temporary closure, such closure shall automatically terminate; now, therefore, be it
3	RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code
4	section 21101(e), the portions of 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, north of Lake Street at the 14 <sup>th</sup>
5	Avenue and 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue Gates, are temporarily closed to vehicular traffic until December 1,
6	2005, and the following regulation governing the movement of vehicles is hereby enacted as
7	designated below:
8	Temporary Street Closure to Vehicular Traffic, At All Times, Every Day Including
9	Holidays until December 1, 2005, Establish
10	14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, north of Lake Street at the 14 <sup>th</sup> Avenue Gate; and
11	15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, north of Lake Street at the 15 <sup>th</sup> Avenue Gate; and, be it
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That during the term of this closure DPT shall monitor local
13	intersections to determine if levels of service for vehicles and pedestrians substantially
14	deteriorate for vehicles and pedestrians; and, be it
15	FURTHER RESOLVED, That should DPT determine that such deterioration has
16	occurred, the closure shall automatically terminate.
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
