

1 [Expand treatment capacity for homeless addicts in San Francisco through residential
2 treatment and service coordination and add two positions.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
5 **accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$499,999 for the third year of a**
6 **three year grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration**
7 **(SAMHSA) for the homeless addict vocational and educational network (HAVEN), to**
8 **enter into an agreement for the use of these funds, and to add two new positions not**
9 **included in the original grant; for the period of September 30, 2004 to September 29,**
10 **2005.**

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12 WHEREAS, SFDPH was awarded a grant from SAMHSA to establish a homeless
13 addict vocational and educational network in San Francisco; and,

14 WHEREAS, SAMHSA has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$499,999 for
15 the third year under the terms of this award; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds SAMHSA requires SFDPH to enter
17 into an agreement (“The Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
18 Supervisors in File No _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
19 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, the addition of two positions to the third year of the grant has been
21 approved by SAMHSA; and

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$1,783; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a
25 grant in the amount of \$499,999 from SAMHSA; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
2 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San
3 Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to add two positions totaling
5 .80 ftes in this, the third year of this grant; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
7 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
9 created under the grant as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when the
10 grant expires.
