

1 [Provide car seats and information to hard to reach and diverse communities.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$2,000 from the California**
5 **Department of Health Services (CDHS), to purchase car/booster seats; for the period of**
6 **January 12, 2004 through June 4, 2004.**

8 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from CDHS in the
9 amount of \$2,000 to provide car/booster seats to hard to reach and diverse communities in
10 San Francisco; and,

11 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDHS requires the City to
12 comply with the terms of an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the
13 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to
14 be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

15 WHEREAS, The SFDPH proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
16 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a
18 grant in the amount of \$2,000 from CDHS; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
20 indirect costs in the budget of the agreement; and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
22 agreement on behalf of the City.
