22	may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually	
23	considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure

9	totaling 2.0 ftes; and, be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
11	agreement on behalf of the City.
