

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - California Governor's Office of Emergency  
2 Services - Victim Witness Assistance Program - \$1,549,288]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept**  
4 **and expend a grant in the amount of \$1,549,288 from the California Governor's**  
5 **Office of Emergency Services for the Victim Witness Assistance Program for the**  
6 **grant period of October 1, 2018, through September 30, 2019.**

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8 WHEREAS, The Office of the District Attorney applied for funding from the  
9 California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) for the "Victim Witness  
10 Assistance Program" and was awarded \$1,549,288; and

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to provide comprehensive assistance  
12 programs for victims and witnesses of crime, and to handle the trauma experienced by  
13 victims and witnesses to allow for faster and more complete recovery from the effects of  
14 crime; and

15 WHEREAS, This recurring grant was budgeted at \$984,876 in the FY2018-2019  
16 and FY2019-2020 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, Ordinance No. 181-18;  
17 and

18 WHEREAS, On December 21, 2018, Cal OES awarded \$1,549,288 which is  
19 \$564,412 more than the FY2018-2019 appropriated funds; and

20 WHEREAS, The amount of \$564,412 is required to be appropriated to equal the  
21 total amount of \$1,549,288 awarded to the Office of the District Attorney for the 2018-19  
22 Federal fiscal year; and

23 WHEREAS, The increased appropriation does not require an amendment to the  
24 Annual Salary Ordinance (ASO); and

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1           WHEREAS, The federal portion of the grant, VOCA, requires a match of  
2 \$193,073; and the source of matching fund is the District Attorney's Office general fund;  
3 and

4           WHEREAS, The grant includes provision for indirect costs of \$137,325; now,  
5 therefore, be it

6           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the  
7 District Attorney to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San  
8 Francisco, a grant of \$1,549,288 from the California Governor's Office of Emergency  
9 Services for the Victim Witness Assistance Program for FY2018-2019 for the period  
10 October 1, 2018, through September 30, 2019.
