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3 **Ordinance amending the Health Code by adding section 3108 to authorize the**
4 **Department of Public Health to charge fees to defray the costs of implementation of**
5 **Article 31 of the Health Code and making environmental findings.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Findings.

11 In accordance with the actions contemplated herein, this Board adopted Resolution No.
12 _____, concerning findings pursuant to the California Environmental
13 Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said Resolution is on
14 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 041533 and is incorporated herein by
15 reference.

16 Section 2. The San Francisco Health Code is hereby amended by adding section
17 3108, to read as follows:

18 Sec. 3108. Fees. The Director is authorized to charge the following fees to defray the costs of
19 document processing and review, consultation with Applicants, and administration of this Article: for
20 fiscal year 2004-2005: (1) an initial fee of \$511.00 upon submission of the site evaluation report; and
21 (2) an additional fee of \$137.00 per hour for document processing and review and applicant
22 consultation exceeding three hours or portion thereof payable on an ongoing basis; for fiscal year
23 2005-2006: (1) an initial fee of \$514.00; and (2) an additional fee of \$145.00 per hour exceeding three
24 hours or portion thereof; for fiscal year 2006-2007: (1) an initial fee of \$539.00; and (2) an additional
25 fee of \$153.00 per hour exceeding three hours or portion thereof. Beginning with fiscal year 2007-

1 2008, no later than April 15 of each year, the Controller shall adjust the fees provided in this Article to
2 reflect changes in the relevant Consumer Price Index, without further action by the Board of
3 Supervisors. In adjusting the fees, the Controller may round these fees up or down to the nearest
4 dollar, half-dollar or quarter-dollar. The Director shall perform an annual review of the fees
5 scheduled to be assessed for the following fiscal year and shall file a report with the Controller no later
6 than May 1st of each year, proposing, if necessary, an adjustment to the fees to ensure that costs are
7 fully recovered and that fees do not produce significantly more revenue than required to cover the costs
8 of operating the program. The Controller shall adjust fees when necessary in either case.
