| 10 | MOVED, That Rule 4.14 of the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors of the City   |
| 11 | and County of San Francisco is hereby amended to read as follows:   |
| 12 | 4.14. Voting Requirement and Procedure. Every Supervisor present when a   |
| 13 | question is put shall vote for or against it, unless excused from voting by motion adopted by a                                   |
| 14 | majority of the Supervisors present or prohibited from voting by provision of state or City law                                   |
| 15 | because of a conflict of interest, which shall be disclosed. Should a Supervisor fail to vote                                     |
| 16 | within one minute of her or his name being called by the Clerk of the Board on a roll call, the                                   |
| 17 | President may, within his or her discretion, and for good cause shown, extend the time for the                                    |
| 18 | Supervisor to vote. Should the Supervisor fail to vote within the time limit imposed under the                                    |
| 19 | provisions of this Rule, then the President shall direct the Clerk of the Board to enter into the                                 |
