

1 [Board Rule Change: Withdrawal of Sponsorship, Withdrawal of Legislation.]

3 **Motion adding Rule 2.12.1 to the Board of Supervisors Rules of Order to allow the**
4 **withdrawal of sponsorship of legislation and providing for the withdrawal from**
5 **consideration by the Board any legislation where, after the withdrawal of sponsorship,**
6 **there remains no sponsoring supervisor.**

12 MOVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors Rules of Order, are hereby
13 amended to add Rule 2.12.1, which reads as follows:

14 2.12.1 Withdrawal of Sponsorship, Withdrawal of Legislation. A sponsoring Supervisor may,
15 at any time, withdraw his or her sponsorship of pending legislation by notifying the Clerk of the Board,
16 in writing, of his or her withdrawal of sponsorship. Withdrawal of sponsorship shall become effective
17 immediately upon receipt of notice by the Clerk. In the event there remains no sponsor to legislation,
18 the legislation is deemed withdrawn and the withdrawal is effective immediately upon receipt of notice
19 by the Clerk. Where there are multiple sponsors of legislation, legislation is deemed withdrawn upon
20 notice to the Clerk that the last remaining sponsor has withdrawn his or her sponsorship. The Clerk
21 shall notify the members of the Board of any withdrawal of sponsorship received pursuant to this rule.
22 Legislation withdrawn by operation of this rule shall be filed by the Clerk.
