3 **Resolution declaring February 4, 2005 as “San Francisco Parent Teacher Association**
4 **(PTA) Day” in the City and County of San Francisco.**

6 WHEREAS, Alice McLellan Birney and Phoebe Apperson Hearst founded the National
7 Congress of Mothers in 1897 which became the National Congress of Parents and Teachers
8 in 1925; and,

9 WHEREAS, Selena Sloan Butler founded the National Congress of Colored Parents
10 and Teachers in 1926; and,

11 WHEREAS, The two groups were united to form the National Parent Teachers
12 Association in 1970; and,

13 WHEREAS, February is the month designated to commemorate the founders of the
14 PTA and to celebrate the dedicated volunteers who work to provide leadership, support and
15 services to our public schools; and,

16 WHEREAS, We gratefully acknowledge the hard work and support of parents,
17 teachers, principals, community groups, San Francisco Unified School District administration
18 and School Board members; and,

19 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors acknowledges the San Francisco
20 Parent Teachers Association’s dedication to support education and provide skills in advocacy,
21 leadership and communication to positively impact the lives of all children; now, therefore be it
