3 **Resolution declaring March 19, 2005 Dr. Anita Friedman Day.**

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Anita Friedman has served as the inspirational, visionary leader of
6 Jewish Family and Children’s Services for the past 25 years; and

7 WHEREAS, During Dr. Anita Friedman’s tenure as Executive Director, the Agency has
8 grown, prospered, and gained tremendous stature locally, regionally, and nationally, building
9 upon the principles of the founders who, in 1850, established this organization to alleviate
10 human suffering and help people live the best lives possible through the provision of
11 preventive, educational, therapeutic and supportive services, emphasizing inter-generational
12 ties and community responsibility; and

13 WHEREAS, Jewish Family and Children’s Services, under Dr. Anita Friedman’s
14 leadership, provides a comprehensive network of services and continuum of care to children,
15 teens, and parents, adults and their families, seniors and their families, people with special
16 needs, and new Americans: and

17 WHEREAS, Through Dr. Anita Friedman’s efforts, Jewish Family and Children’s
18 Services serves 50,000 people annually in the West Bay Area of California; now, therefore, be
