3	Ordinance amending the San Francisco Traffic Code by amending Section 203.1 to
4	increase the rate for parking meters in Parking Meter Area Number One to three dollars
5	(\$3.00) an hour, by amending Section 203.2 and 203.4 to increase the rate for parking
6	meters in Parking Meter Areas Numbers Two and Four to two dollars and fifty cents
7	(\$2.50) an hour, and by amending Section 203.3 to increase the rate for parking meters
8	in Parking Meter Area Number Three to <del>two<u>one</u> dollars <u>and fifty cents (</u>\$<del>2.00<u>1.50</u>) an</del></del>
9	hour.

13	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
14	Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending Sections
15	203.1, 203.2, 203.3, and 203.4, to read as follows:
16	SEC. 203.1. PARKING METER RATESPARKING METER AREA NUMBER ONE.
17	The rates for parking meters in Parking Meter Area Number One shall be <i>three dollars</i>
18	<u>an hour</u> . <del>as follows:</del>
19	(a) A five-cent piece (nickel) shall allow a parking time period of one and one-half
20	minutes following the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of five-cent pieces may be repeated for a
21	like period of time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or
22	(b) A ten-cent piece (dime) shall allow a parking time period of three minutes following
23	the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of ten-cent pieces may be repeated for a like period of time
24	until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or

(c) A twenty-five cent piece (quarter) shall allow a parking time period of seven and one-

- 2 half minutes following the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of quarters may be repeated for a like 3

period of time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended.

- 4 <del>(d)</del> The maximum time period permitted for parking at any parking meter, whether 5 operational or broken, on the posted days and during the posted hours of its operation shall 6 correspond to the time designated on the parking meter.

## SEC. 203.2. PARKING METER RATES--PARKING METER AREA NUMBER TWO.

- 8 The rates for parking meters in Parking Meter Area Number Two shall be two dollars
- 9 and fifty cents an hour.as follows:
- 10 - (a) A five-cent piece (nickel) shall allow a parking time period of two minutes following
- 11 the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of five-cent pieces may be repeated for a like period of time
- 12 until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or
- 13 (b) A ten-cent piece (dime) shall allow a parking time period of two minutes following the
- 14 deposit of such coin, and such deposit of ten-cent pieces may be repeated for a like period of time until
- 15 the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or
- 16 - (c) A twenty-five cent piece (quarter) shall allow a parking time period of ten minutes
- 17 following the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of quarters may be repeated for a like period of
- 18 time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended.
- The maximum time period permitted for parking at any parking meter, whether 19 -(d)20 operational or broken, on the posted days and during the posted hours of its operation shall 21 correspond to the maximum time designated on the parking meter.
- 22 SEC. 203.3. PARKING METER RATES--PARKING METER AREA NUMBER
- 23 THREE.
- 24 The rates for parking meters in Parking Meter Area Number Three shall be as
- 25 *follows*:two dollars<u>one dollar and fifty cents</u> *an hour*.

1 (a) A five-cent piece (nickel) shall allow a parking time period of three minutes following

- 2 *the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of five-cent pieces may be repeated for a like period of time*
- 3 *until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or*
- 4 (b) A ten-cent piece (dime) shall allow a parking time period of six minutes following the
- 5 *deposit of such coin, and such deposit of ten-cent pieces may be repeated for a like period of time until*
- 6 *the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or*
- 7 (c) A twenty-five cent piece (quarter) shall allow a parking time period of fifteen minutes

8 following the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of twenty-five cent pieces may be repeated for a

- 9 *like period of time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended.*
- 10 -(d) The maximum time period permitted for parking at any parking meter, whether 11 operational or broken, on the posted days and during the posted hours of its operation shall 12 correspond to the time designated on the parking meter.

## SEC. 203.4. PARKING METER RATES--PARKING METER AREA NUMBER FOUR.

- The rates for parking meters in Parking Meter Area Number Four shall be *as follows:two dollars and fifty cents an hour.*
- 16 *(a) A five-cent piece (nickel) shall allow a parking time period of two minutes following*
- 17 *the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of five-cent pieces may be repeated for a like period of time*
- 18 *until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or*
- 19 (b) A ten-cent piece (dime) shall allow a parking time period of four minutes following the
- 20 *deposit of such coin, and such deposit of ten-cent pieces may be repeated for a like period of time until*
- 21 *the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or*
- 22 *(c) A twenty-five cent piece (quarter) shall allow a parking time period of ten minutes*
- 23 following the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of quarters may be repeated for a like period of
- 24 *time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended.*
